



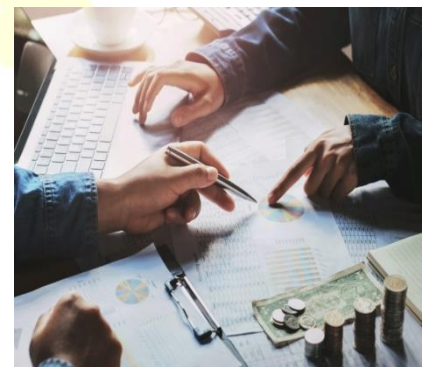

 - (e) Also make a **logo** for your company.



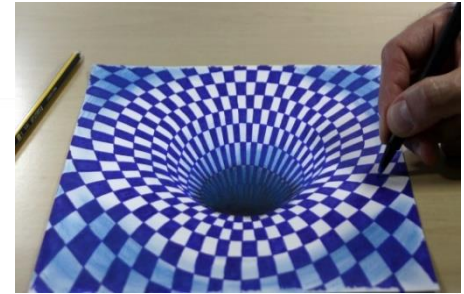
2. Make a PPT over “**Violence against children in India**”.
